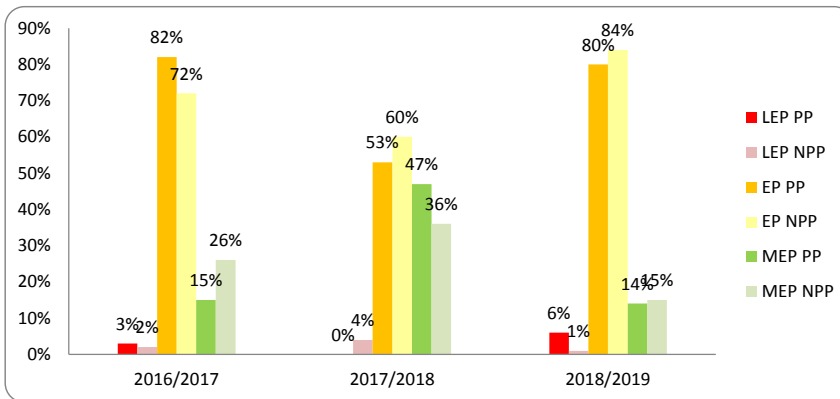

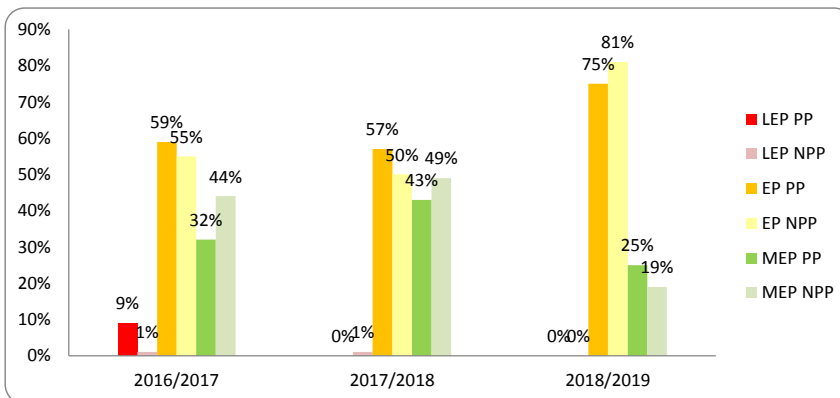
## Comparison of Pupil Progress 2016-2017 vs 2017-2018 vs 2018 - 2019

### PP- Language and Literacy



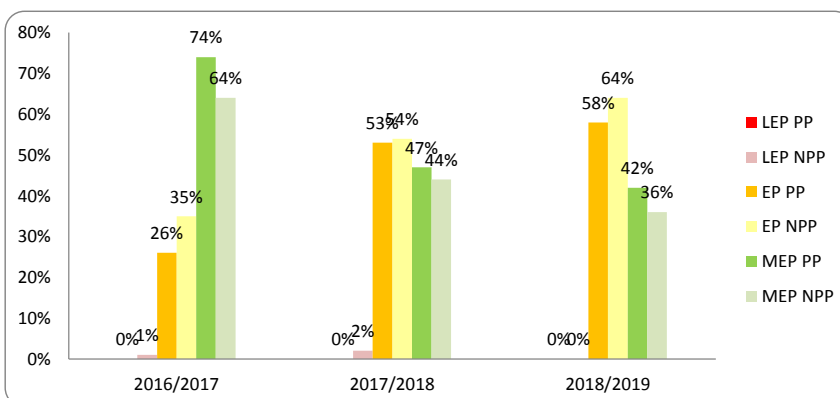
The data for Language and Literacy continues to present a positive picture with 94% of pupils classified as Pupil Premium making at least expected progress. The 6% of pupils (3 pupils) who made less than expected progress have been targeted for intervention in Reading and Writing.

### PP - Mathematics



The data for Mathematics continues to present a positive picture with 100% of pupils classified as Pupil Premium making at least expected progress or better.

### PP - PSD



The data for Personal Social Development continues to present a positive picture with 100% of pupils classified as Pupil Premium making at least expected progress or better.
