If one member of a family has the infestation it is necessary to treat all family members to prevent a re-occurrence of the problem.

Anyone who has experienced head lice will know that the condition is very uncomfortable and unpleasant but with your cooperation this problem can be effectively controlled.

Products for treatment are available from chemists or on a doctor's prescription.
